- The members of the Task Force shall elect a chair-from the membership.
- (d) <u>The Maryland-Higher-Education Commission shall provide-staff-for-the</u>

 Task-Force:
 - (e) A member of the Task Force:
 - (1) may not receive compensation as a member of the Task Force; but
- (2) is-entitled to reimbursement for expenses under the Standard State Travel Regulations, as provided in the State budget.
 - (f) The Task Force shall:
- (1) examine retail-prices of textbooks for higher education-students in the State, including average and median prices for undergraduate, graduate, and community college student textbooks:
 - (2) study factors that impact retail prices of textbooks, including:
 - how professors-choose textbooks for their classes:
- (ii) the amount-retail-booksellers-increase-retail-prices-above
 - (iii) publishers' methods of setting list-prices;
- (iv) publishers' methods of marketing textbooks to professors; and
- (v) any other factors the Task Force identifies as impacting retail prices paid by higher education students for textbooks; and
- (3) develop-recommendations for providing-financial-relief-to-students and-families relating to the price of textbooks.
- (g) <u>In performing its duties, the Task-Force may invite all interested groups and individuals to present testimony or other information to the Task Force.</u>
- (h) On or before September 1, 2008, the Task Force shall report its-findings and-recommendations to the Governor and, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, the General Assembly.
- SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That on or before November 1, 2007, the Department of Legislative
