~~(2)~~ (II) A PERSON, ~~OR A SUBSIDIARY, AFFILIATE, AGENT, OR ASSIGNEE OF THE PERSON,~~ THAT WAS GIVEN ACCESS TO THE CONSUMER'S CONSUMER REPORT UNDER SUBSECTION (E) OF THIS SECTION FOR THE PURPOSE OF FACILITATING AN EXTENSION OF CREDIT TO THE CONSUMER OR ANOTHER PERMISSIBLE USE;

~~(3)~~ (III) A PERSON ACTING IN ACCORDANCE WITH A COURT ORDER, WARRANT, OR SUBPOENA;
