SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That the Maryland Library for the Blind and Physically Handicapped shall consult and coordinate with the State Department of Education to facilitate the utilization of equipment and staff being used to provide instructional materials to students who are blind or print disabled in primary and secondary education in order to minimize the costs associated with this Act.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect June October 1, 2007.

CHAPTER 319

(Senate Bill 271)

AN ACT concerning

Hunting - Exemptions from License and Stamp Requirement

FOR the purpose of expanding the exemption from the hunting license and stamp requirement for hunting on farmland to include certain spouses and certain persons who live on, work on, or manage the farmland; and generally relating to the exemptions for the hunting license and stamp requirement.

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Natural Resources
