SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Real Property

11-109.3.

(A) UNIT OWNERS ENTITLED TO CAST AT LEAST 60% OF THE VOTES IN THE COUNCIL OF UNIT OWNERS MAY PETITION THE CIRCUIT COURT FOR THE COUNTY—WHERE THE CONDOMINIUM IS LOCATED TO APPOINT A AN INDEPENDENT RECEIVER TO MANAGE THE AFFAIRS OF THE COUNCIL OF UNIT
