(8) THE BOARD MAY DENY, SUSPEND, OR REVOKE THE PERMIT OF A WHOLESALE DISTRIBUTOR IF THE BOARD DETERMINES THAT THE WHOLESALE DISTRIBUTOR NO LONGER QUALIFIES FOR A PERMIT.
