- (1)** ESTABLISH RECORD-KEEPING REQUIREMENTS;
- (2)** ESTABLISH REPORTING REQUIREMENTS;
- (3)** SET FEES;
- (4)** ESTABLISH HOLDING PERIODS;
- (5)** ESTABLISH METHODS OF ENFORCEMENT;
- (6)** SET CIVIL PENALTIES;
- (7)** DEFINE TERMS; AND

(8) REGULATE PAWNBROKERS AND SECONDHAND ~~PRECIOUS METAL OBJECT~~ DEALERS AS NECESSARY TO CARRY OUT THE INTENT OF THIS SECTION.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.

Carroll County - Alcoholic Beverages - Quota for Class A Licenses
