- (g) (1) "Oil" means oil of any kind and in any liquid form including:
  - (i) Petroleum;
  - (ii) Petroleum by-products;
  - (iii) Fuel oil;
  - (iv) Sludge containing oil or oil residues;
  - (v) Oil refuse;
- (vi) Oil mixed with or added to or otherwise contaminating soil, waste, or any other liquid or solid media;
  - (vii) Crude oils;
  - (viii) Aviation fuel;
  - (ix) Gasoline;
  - (x) Kerosene;
  - (xi) Light and heavy fuel oils;
- (xii) Diesel motor <del>fuels</del> <u>FUEL</u>, <u>INCLUDING BIODIESEL FUEL</u>, <u>REGARDLESS OF WHETHER THE FUEL IS PETROLEUM BASED</u>;
  - (xiii) Asphalt; [and]
