A LICENSEE SHALL IDENTIFY AND REPRESENT THEMSELVES BY PROFESSION AND DEGREE EARNED.

- (a) Except as provided for a limited license in §§ 2-310[, 2-310.1, and 2-310.2] **THROUGH 2-310.3** of this subtitle, a license expires on the date set by the Board, unless the license is renewed for an additional term as provided in this section. [A license may not be renewed for a term longer than 2 years.]
- (b) At least [1 month] 2 MONTHS before the license expires, the Board shall [send to the licensee, by first—class mail to the last known address given to the Board by the licensee, a renewal notice that states] CONTACT THE LICENSEE AT THE LAST KNOWN ADDRESS PROVIDED BY THE LICENSEE AND ADVISE THE LICENSEE OF:
 - (1) The date on which the current license expires;
- (2) The date by which the renewal application must be received by the Board for the renewal to be issued and mailed before the license expires; and
 - (3) The amount of the renewal fee.
- (c) [Except as otherwise provided in subsection (d) of this section, before] **BEFORE** the license expires, the licensee periodically may renew it for an additional [2-year] term, if the licensee:
