

(1) Is authorized to practice speech-language pathology in this State;
or

(2) Evaluates, examines, instructs, or counsels individuals suffering from disorders or conditions that affect speech [and], language, **COMMUNICATION, AND SWALLOWING.**

(b) Unless authorized to practice speech-language pathology under this title **OR UNLESS OTHERWISE PROVIDED FOR UNDER THIS ARTICLE**, a person may not use any word or term connoting professional proficiency in speech-language pathology, including but not limited to:

- (1) "Communication disorders";
- (2) "Communicologist";
- (3) **"DYSPHAGIST";**
- [(3)] (4) "Language pathologist";
- [(4)] (5) "Logopedist";
- [(5)] (6) "Speech and language clinician";
- [(6)] (7) "Speech and language therapist";
- [(7)] (8) "Speech clinic";
- [(8)] (9) "Speech clinician";
- [(9)] (10) "Speech correction";
- [(10)] (11) "Speech correctionist";
- [(11)] (12) "Speech pathology";
- [(12)] (13) "Speech-language pathology";
- [(13)] (14) "Speech therapist"; [or]
- [(14)] (15) "Speech therapy"; **OR**
- (16) **"SWALLOWING THERAPIST".**
