- (e) (5) This <u>SUBSECTION</u> does not apply [to any licenses or] to any license issued under § 6–201(r)(2) [or], (5), OR (15) or § 7–101 of this article.
- (f) (i) [A] EXCEPT AS PROVIDED IN § 6-201(R)(15) OF THIS ARTICLE, A person, whether acting on that person's behalf or on the behalf of another person or entity, corporation, association, partnership, limited partnership or other combination of persons (natural or otherwise) for whatever reason formed, may not have an interest in more than one license authorizing the retail or wholesale sale of alcoholic beverages.
- (2) This subsection does not apply to licenses issued under the provisions of § 6-201(r)(2), (3), (5), (7), [or] (10), OR (15), § 7-101, or § 8-505 of this article or to club licenses.
- (5) (i) This paragraph does not apply to a [licensed premises] RESTAURANT located [in] WITHIN a chain store, supermarket, discount house, drug store, or convenience store.
- (ii) [Notwithstanding any other provision of this article, the] THE Board of License Commissioners may [allow an individual, partnership, corporation, unincorporated association, or limited liability company to hold or have an interest in more than one Class B beer, wine and liquor license, if the restaurant for which the license is sought is located] ISSUE A CLASS B DD LICENSE FOR A RESTAURANT within:
- 1. Any of the following areas that are underserved by restaurants:
- A. Suitland business district, consisting of properties fronting on or having access to Silver Hill Road between Suitland Parkway and Sunset Lane, and on Suitland Road between Arnold Road and Eastern Lane;
- B. Part of the Port Towns business district, consisting of properties fronting on or having access to Rhode Island Avenue, Bladensburg Road, Annapolis Road, or 38th Street, in legislative district 22; for
- C. Largo area, consisting of properties within the area bounded by the Capital Beltway (I–495) on the west, Central Avenue and Landover Road on the south and southeast, Campus Way North on the east and Route 214 and Landover Road on the north and northwest; or
- D. CAPITAL PLAZA COMMERCIAL AREA, CONSISTING
 OF COMMERCIAL PROPERTIES WITHIN THE AREA BOUNDED BY THE
 BALTIMORE WASHINGTON PARKWAY ON THE WEST AND NORTHWEST.
