## (6) (4) SEEK GRANT FUNDING TO:

- (I) DEVELOP AND ESTABLISH A CASE MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR ADULTS WITH SICKLE CELL DISEASE; AND
- (II) ESTABLISH AN ADULT SICKLE CELL DISEASE DAY INFUSION CENTER;
