health care provider shall have 6 months from the date of denial, unless a carrier permits a longer time period, to submit a claim for reimbursement for the service to the carrier, Maryland Medical Assistance Program, or Medicare Program responsible for payment.

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall apply to claims paid by Maryland Medical Assistance Program managed care organizations on or after July 1, 2007.

SECTION 2-3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2007.
