

SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Environment

~~(A)~~ Except for violations of Part III of this subtitle, ~~VIOLATIONS OF §§ 9-228 AND 9-229 OF THIS SUBTITLE,~~ and violations enforced under ~~§ 9-267 §§ 9-229(B), 9-267, AND 9-268.1~~ of this subtitle, the provisions of §§ 9-334 through [9-342] ~~9-343 9-344~~ of Subtitle 3 of this title shall be used and shall apply to enforce violations of:

- (1) This subtitle;
- (2) Any regulation adopted under this subtitle; or
- (3) Any order or permit issued under this subtitle.

~~(B) (1) THE ATTORNEY GENERAL SHALL REPRESENT THE STATE IN EVERY CASE DESCRIBED IN THIS SECTION, INCLUDING THE RECOVERY OF ANY FINES OR PENALTIES.~~

~~(2) THIS SUBSECTION MAY NOT LIMIT OR AFFECT THE POWER OR AUTHORITY OF THE STATE'S ATTORNEY FOR A COUNTY UNDER ARTICLE 10, § 34 OF THE CODE.~~

SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007.
