SECTION 2. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That Section(s) 2-106(d) and (e), respectively, of Article – Labor and Employment of the Annotated Code of Maryland be renumbered to be Section(s) 2-106(c) and (d), respectively.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That nothing in this Act chall be construed to preempt a county or municipal government from enacting and enforcing more stringent measures to reduce involuntary exposure to environmental tobacco smoke.

SECTION 4. 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect October 1, 2007 <u>January 1, 2008</u> October 1, 2007.
