SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

Article - Election Law

9-102.

(A) IN THIS SECTION, A "VOTER-VERIFIABLE PAPER RECORD" INCLUDES:

(1) A PAPER BALLOT PREPARED BY THE VOTER FOR THE PURPOSE OF BEING READ BY A PRECINCT-BASED OPTICAL SCANNER;
