of the Maryland Health Insurance Plan Fund may be transferred and appropriated in the budget bill or by budget amendment to the Department of Health and Mental Hygiene for the purpose of providing a grant, not to exceed \$425,000, to the Maryland Medbank Program under § 15–124.2 of the Health – General Article.

SECTION 3. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That this Act shall take effect July 1, 2007.

## CHAPTER 637

(House Bill 1017)

AN ACT concerning

## Baltimore City and Prince George's County - Parent-Teacher Association Matching Fund Pilot Program

FOR the purpose of establishing the Parent-Teacher Association Matching Fund Pilot Program; providing for the purpose of the Program; requiring the State-to provide a dollar for dollar match up to a certain amount for funds raised by parent teacher associations in public high schools in Baltimore City and Prince George's County; providing that each public high school in Baltimore City and Prince George's County is eligible for a dollar-for-dollar match for private funds raised by the school's parent-teacher association up to a certain amount; limiting the total amount that may be expended under the Program annually; providing for Program funds; defining a certain term; requiring certain persons to submit a certain report to certain committees of the General Assembly on or before a certain date; providing for the termination of this Act; and generally relating to the Parent-Teacher Association Matching Fund Pilot Program.
