- (A) IN THIS SECTION, "PROGRAM" MEANS THE PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION MATCHING FUND PILOT PROGRAM.
- (B) THERE IS A PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION MATCHING FUND PILOT PROGRAM IN BALTIMORE CITY AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.
  - (C) THE PURPOSE OF THE PROGRAM IS TO:
- (1) ENCOURAGE PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATIONS TO RAISE FUNDS FOR PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS; AND
- (2) PROVIDE ADDITIONAL STATE FUNDS FOR PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS.
- (D) THE STATE SHALL-PROVIDE A DOLLAR-FOR DOLLAR MATCH UP TO \$250,000 FOR PRIVATE—FUNDS—RAISED—BY—EACH—PARENT TEACHER ASSOCIATION—IN A PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL—IN BALTIMORE—CITY—AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.
- (D) (1) EACH PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOL IN BALTIMORE CITY AND PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY IS ELIGIBLE FOR A DOLLAR-FOR-DOLLAR MATCH FOR PRIVATE FUNDS RAISED BY THE SCHOOL'S PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION UP TO:
- (I) IN BALTIMORE CITY, THE AMOUNT RAISED BY THE PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION, NOT TO EXCEED THE SCHOOL'S EQUAL SHARE AS DETERMINED BY DIVIDING \$125,000 BY THE NUMBER OF PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS IN BALTIMORE CITY; AND
- (II) IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY, THE AMOUNT RAISED BY THE PARENT-TEACHER ASSOCIATION, NOT TO EXCEED THE SCHOOL'S EQUAL SHARE AS DETERMINED BY DIVIDING \$125,000 BY THE NUMBER OF PUBLIC HIGH SCHOOLS IN PRINCE GEORGE'S COUNTY.
- (2) The total amount expended under the Program may not exceed \$250,000 \$200,000 annually.
- (E) FUNDS FOR THE PROGRAM SHALL BE AS PROVIDED IN THE STATE BUDGET BY THE GOVERNOR.
