SECTION 1. BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF  
MARYLAND, That the Laws of Maryland read as follows:

  - (11) the Department of Natural Resources;
  - (12) the State Department of Education;
  - (13) the Department of State Police;
