AND TO PROVIDE THAT THIS TITLE IS A FAIR SUMMARY OF SUCH CHARTER AMENDMENTS; AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PROCEDURES TO BE FOLLOWED FOR THE EFFECTIVENESS OF THIS CHARTER AMENDMENT RESOLUTION.
