<u>City and for public school construction and rehabilitation of Baltimore City public schools.</u>

SECTION 10. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED, That:

- (a) (1) In this section the following words have the meanings indicated.
- (2) "Ballot issue committee" has the meaning stated in § 1–101(f) of the Election Law Article.
- (3) "Campaign finance report" has the meaning stated in § 1-101(i) of the Election Law Article.
- (4) "Campaign material" has the meaning stated in § 1-101(k) of the Election Law Article.
- (b) A ballot issue committee that is formed to promote the success or defeat of the constitutional amendment proposed by Chapter 5 (S.B. 4/H.B. 4) of the Acts of the General Assembly of the Special Session of 2007 shall file, in addition to the campaign finance reports required under § 13-309 of the Election Law Article, a campaign finance report on or before the fourth Friday immediately preceding the 2008 general election.
- (c) A corporation that cumulatively spends more than \$10,000 on campaign material to promote the success or defeat of the constitutional amendment proposed by Chapter 5 (S.B. 4/H.B. 4) of the Acts of the General Assembly of the Special Session of 2007 shall:
- (1) file a campaign finance report on the same dates as required for a ballot issue committee under § 13–309 of the Election Law Article and this Act; and
- (2) include the information required under § 13-401 of the Election Law Article on all campaign material published or distributed by the corporation to promote the success or defeat of the constitutional amendment proposed by Chapter 5 (S.B. 4/H.B. 4) of the Acts of the General Assembly of the Special Session of 2007.
- SECTION 11. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That Section 10 of this Act shall take effect January 1, 2008, contingent on the passage of Chapter 5 (S.B. 4/H.B. 4) of the Acts of the General Assembly of the Special Session of 2007.

SECTION 12. AND BE IT FURTHER ENACTED. That this Act shall be contingent on the passage of Chapter 5 (S.B. 4/H.B. 4) of the Acts of the General Assembly of the Special Session of 2007, a constitutional amendment, and its ratification by the voters of the State.
