~~(a) In this section, "Program" means the Parent Teacher Association Matching Fund Pilot Program.~~

~~(b) There is a Parent Teacher Association Matching Fund Pilot Program in Baltimore City and Prince George's County.~~

~~(c) The purpose of the Program is to:~~

~~(1) Encourage parent teacher associations to raise funds for public high schools; and~~

~~(2) Provide additional State funds for public high schools.~~

~~(d) (1) Each public high school in Baltimore City and Prince George's County is eligible for a dollar for dollar match for private funds raised by the school's parent teacher association up to:~~

~~(i) In Baltimore City, the amount raised by the parent teacher association, not to exceed the school's equal share as determined by dividing \$125,000 by the number of public high schools in Baltimore City; and~~

~~(ii) In Prince George's County, the amount raised by the parent teacher association, not to exceed the school's equal share as determined by dividing \$125,000 by the number of public high schools in Prince George's County.~~

~~(2) The total amount expended under the Program may not exceed \$200,000 annually.~~

~~(e) Funds for the Program shall be as provided in the State budget by the Governor.~~

~~(f) On or before December 1 of each year, the Chief Executive Officer of the Baltimore City Public School System and the Superintendent of Schools of Prince George's County shall report to the Senate Budget and Taxation Committee and the House Ways and Means Committee, in accordance with § 2-1246 of the State Government Article, on the status of, and the benefits accrued from, the Parent Teacher Association Matching Fund Pilot Program.~~
