GOVERNOR AND, IN ACCORDANCE WITH § 2–1246 OF THE STATE GOVERNMENT ARTICLE, TO THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY A TAX INCIDENCE STUDY MEASURING THE BURDEN OF ALL THE MAJOR TAXES IMPOSED BY THE STATE AND HOW THAT BURDEN IS SHARED AMONG TAXPAYERS OF DIFFERENT INCOME LEVELS.

(2) The Bureau shall prepare and submit the statistics of income report required under § 10-223 of the Tax - General Article.
