 at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said Joseph Yates do hereby
 acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant bargain and sell, unto the
 said William H. Yates his Executors administrators, and assigns, all the goods hereinafter particularly described
 and mentioned, that is to say - Prose of Wheat now on the farm where I now reside one White Horse, one
 black Cow and Calf six head of hogs, one horse Cart, one four wheel Carriage, three ploughs and
 one Harrow, one lot of Carpenters tools and Chest, one set of black Smiths tools at Church Creek one bed
 bedstead and furniture, one Clock, one hundred pounds of bacon, All and singular which said goods and
 Chattels are now remaining and being in a Certain tenement situate in Dorchester County aforesaid, and now
 in the occupation of the said Joseph Yates. So Have and So Hold, all and singular, the said goods, Household
