of Dorchester County has granted bargained and sold Conveyed and transferred and by these presents  
doth grant Bargain and sell Convey and transfer unto the said Severn Johnson his heirs  
and assigns forever two negroes that is to say one negro man John aged twenty five years or thereabouts  
and one negro girl named Jane aged twenty years or thereabouts both slaves for life and now  
in the possession of the said Severn Johnson To have and To Hold the above described  
negro man John and negro girl Jane unto the said Severn Johnson his heirs and assigns  
forever and to and for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever against me the said John W.  
Hayward Administrator of Alexander Simmons and my heirs and against all persons whatever
