

day light for the residue of the year commencing the tenth day of May 1834, and ending twelve months thereafter and shall keep constantly and in good order a scow that will safely carry three passengers and their horses at one trip with one able bodied skillful hand to attend the said ferry and shall not charge, or receive any greater price for ferriage than what is allowed him by law then the above obligation to be void; otherwise of full force and virtue in law

Be it remembered and it is hereby certified that the following Certificate of negroes was received and recorded on the 1st day of June 1834 to wit: I Edward W. Leconte, of Cambridge, Dorchester County, Maryland, do hereby certify that the following is a true and correct list of the negroes belonging to and in the possession of my wife Mary Elizabeth Leconte (formerly Mary Elizabeth Wall) at the time of my marriage with her to wit; on the Seventh day of December Eighteen hundred and fifty three - containing as near as practicable, the names and ages of the said negroes filed for records under the provisions of the act of the General assembly of Maryland passed December session 1842, Chapter 293, Section 7 - (see the will of Levin H. Wall, dec'd, recorded in the office of the Register of Wills for Dorchester County)
