To all whom it may Concern, be it known, that F. Francis J. Henry of Dorchester County, in the State of Maryland, for divers good causes and Considerations me thereunto moving, have released from Slavery, liberated, manumitted and set free, and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery, liberate, manumit and set free, my negro woman, named Sarah Skinner, being of the age of Forty years, and able to work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance; and her, the said negro woman, named Sarah Skinner, I do declare to be henceforth free, manumitted and discharged, from all manner of Servitude or Service to me, my executors or administrators, forever.
