 hands for collection within the time limited by law and shall also well and truly pay all sums of
 money received by him and also collect and pay all public dues fines & forfeitures which are due
 or belonging to the State and shall also well and faithfully execute and return all writs process
 and warrants to him directed and delivered and shall also pay and deliver to the person or persons
 entitled to receive the same all sum or sums of money, tobacco goods, chattels or property by him
 levied seized or taken agreeably to the directions of the writ process or warrant under which the same
