Andrews and Robert W. Andrews have granted Bargained and sold conveyed and transferred and by these presents do grant Bargain and sell convey and transfer unto the said William Mills his heirs and assigns forever all their right and interest of us and to one negro girl named Jane aged five years a slave for life and now in the possession of the said William Mills. To Have and To Hold the above described negro girl Jane unto the said William Mills his heirs and assigns forever and to and for no other use intent or purpose whatsoever against us the said John R. Andrews and Robert W. Andrews and our heirs and against all persons whatsoever Claiming the said negro girl Jane we shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents - In testimony whereof the said John R. Andrews and Robert W. Andrews have hereunto subscribed their names and affixed their seals this the fifteenth day of January Eighteen hundred and fifty five
