McKins of Dorchester County, and State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and Fifty dollars current money to me in hand paid by Robert McKins of Dorchester County and State of Maryland have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Robert McKins his heirs and assigns, the following negro Girl Emily Slave for life To Have and To Hold the said negro Girl Emily sold by me the said Solomon G. Kirwan by order of the orphan Court on the 14th of December 1834 as above bargained and sold unto the said Robert McKins his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
