To all whom it may concern, be it known that we  
 Thomas Lambden & Margaret Lambden his wife of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland,  
 for divers good Causes and Considerations, we thereunto moving, have released from Slavery liberated,  
 manumitted, and set free, and by these presents do hereby release from Slavery, liberate, manumit,  
 and set free, our negro woman Affa Stevens being of the age of Twenty Seven years, and able to  
 work and gain a sufficient livelihood and maintenance, and for the said negro woman, named  
 Affa Stevens, we do declare to be henceforth free manumitted and discharged from all manner  
 of Service or Servitude to us, our executors or administrators forever —
