Be it remembered and it is hereby Certified that the following Bill of Sale was received and recorded on the 3 day of August in the year of our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty five to wit:

Know all men by these presents, that I, William Creighton of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars Current money of Maryland to me in hand paid by Charlotte Creighton of Baltimore City and State aforesaid, at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof I, the said William Creighton do hereby acknowledge have granted, bargained, and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said Charlotte Creighton (negress) her heirs executors administrators & assigns, One negro girl named Isabella Wheatley aged 10 years a Slave for life. To Have and To Hold the said negro girl Isabella Wheatley as above bargained and sold, or mentioned and intended as to be, to the said Charlotte Creighton (negress) her heirs, executors administrators and assigns, forever; and I the said William Creighton for myself, my heirs, executors and administrators, all and singular the said negro girl Isabella Wheatley and other the premises unto the said Charlotte Creighton her executors administrators and assigns, against me the said William Creighton my Executors and administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents. In Witness whereof the said William Creighton hath hereunto set his hand and seal this second day of August Eighteen Hundred and fifty five signed sealed and delivered
