Rawley of the same County & State, and also before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, I have granted bargained & sold, and by these presents do grant bargain & sell unto the said Noah S. Rawley his executors administrators and assigns, a negro woman named "Romie Parker" & her infant child "Mattha Elizabeth" To Have and To Hold the said herein described negro woman & her child as Slaves for life, above bargained and sold mentioned or intended so to be, to the said Noah S. Rawley his executors administrators or assigns, forever and I the said James S. Colston
