Richardson, for and in consideration of the premises and the sum of five dollars current money to them in hand paid by the said Robert R. Christopher at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Robert R. Christopher his executors administrators and assigns, one negro girl slave named Lovenia aged sixteen years, To Have and To Hold the said negro girl slave Lovenia unto the said Robert R. Christopher his executors administrators and assigns to his and their own use and behoof provided always & it is declared to be the true intent and meaning of these presents that if the said
