Joel Cornwell Be it remembered and it is hereby Certified that the following Bill of Sale was received and recorded on the 23rd day of September 1852 to wit: Know all men by these presents, That Washington Rumbly of Worcester County and State of Maryland, for and in Consideration of the sum of one hundred and twenty seven Dollars and nine Cents lawful money of the United States, in hand paid by Joseph Cornwell at and before the Sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; I have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the Said Joel Cornwell his Executors, Administrators and assigns, one Brown mare named Dove, one yoke Oxen, 1 Ox Cart - Seventy five Barrels of Corn more or less twenty Bushels wheat 1 Cow and Calf 1 lot top & Black fodder 1 Bedstead & Covering & two Shoats All of which property I have this bill of Sale to the Said Joel Cornwell to secure him against loss of the above named item or any part thereof and it is further understood and agreed that when said Rumbly shall well and truly pay to the aforesaid Cornwell the amount above specified (\$127.09) the aforesaid Cornwell shall deliver up to said Rumbly the property above mentioned provided the amount above mentioned shall be paid on or before the 1st day of January next otherwise a public Sale shall be held to satisfy the same for Cash To Have and To Hold the Said described Brown mare, yoke Oxen, Cart, Corn wheat Cow & Calf top & Black fodder 1 Bedstead & Covering & Shoats to the Said Joel Cornwell his Executors, Administrators and assigns forever; and by the Said Washington Rumbly for himself Heirs, Executors and Administrators, the Said property unto the Said Joel Cornwell his Executors, Administrators and assigns, against him the Said Washington Rumbly his Executors and administrators, and against all and every other persons or persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents.
