of these presents the receipt whereof I, the said B. Gaither, do hereby acknowledge,
have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents do grant, bargain and
sell, unto the said Daniel N. James, his executors, administrators, and assigns,
negro man Levin Triger, now in the occupancy of John North, living or residing
on Fishing Creek, To Have and to hold the said negro man above bargained
and sold or mentioned and intended so to be, to the said Daniel N. James,
his executors and administrators, and assigns, forever; and I the said
B. Gaither Subman, for myself, heirs, executors, and administrators, doth
sell the said negro man Levin Triger unto the said Daniel N. James, his executors
and administrators and assigns against me the said B. Gaither Subman my
executors and administrators and against all and every other person or
persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents
