Jones of the County and State aforesaid the recpt. whereof I do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained sold and delivered and by these presents do grant bargain sell and deliver unto the said George W. Jones a negro girl named Caroline age 8 years or thereabouts and a negro boy named John age 5 years or thereabouts both Slaves for life which said property I will warrant and defend to the said George W. Jones his Executors administrators and assigns aqt. me my Executors administrators and aqt. every other person or persons whomsoever

In witness whereof we have hereunto set our names and affixed our seals this 28th day of September in the year Eighteen hundred and fifty five
