Be it remembered and it is hereby Certified, that the following Bill of Sale was received and recorded on the 20th day of January, Anno Domini, 1850 to wit: Knew all men by these presents, that we Henry P. Hubbard, Thomas C. Bennett and Mary Bennett his wife, James M. Mills and Lydia M. Mills his wife, of Dorchester County in the State of Maryland, for and in Consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred Dollars Current money of Maryland, to us in hand paid by Rebecca Wheeler of the same County and State aforesaid, at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof we the said Henry P. Hubbard, Thomas C. Bennett and Mary his wife, James M. Mills and Lydia M. his wife, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents do grant, bargain and sell, unto the said Rebecca Wheeler her heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns, the following negroes, to wit: one negro man named Maria aged about twenty nine years a slave for life, and her Child Mantha aged about two years a slave for life, the said negroes Maria and Mantha are sold to the said Rebecca Wheeler to remain in the State of Maryland, and not to be carried beyond the limits of said State. Do Have and Do Hold the said negroes Maria and Mantha as above bargained and sold, or mentioned, or intended so to be, to the said Rebecca Wheeler, her heirs, Executors, administrators and assigns forever.
