 and Sarah Woolford etc and before the execution of these presents, the receipt of which is hereby  
 acknowledged, the said James Woolford has bargained and sold, Conveyed and transferred,  
 and by these presents does bargain and sell Convey and transfer unto the said Ally Woolford  
 Mary E. Woolford, and Sarah A. Woolford their heirs and assigns forever, all the undivided  
 interests, rights, title and estate either in Law or equity of the said James Woolford of in to  
 and out of the following property to wit: One negro man named George, One ditto named  
 Peter, one ditto named Henry, One negro boy named Peter, one ditto named Daniel  
 One negro woman named Silvia, one ditto named Seab, one ditto named Minty, and one  
 ditto named Dey, One negro girl named Chloe, one ditto named Betty, and ditto  
 named Kate and one negro boy, and infants not named - also all the household and  
 kitchen furniture, horses, Cattle, Sheep and hogs, Carriage, and Crop of Corn now  
 on the grounds, blades and top fodder, and straw now standing and being on the farms  
 occupied by the said James Woolford in conjunction with his mother and brothers and sisters
