Seave that will safely carry three Passengers and three Cows above trips, with one able bodied and skillful hand to attend the said Ferry, and shall not charge or receive any greater price for services than what is allowed by Law—

Prohman of Dorchester County, in the State of Maryland are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland, in the full and just sum of Fifty Five thousand and forty nine Dollars and six Cents Current money of the United States, to be paid to the said State or its Certain Attorney, to the which pay-ment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves and each of us, our and each of our heirs, Executors and administrators, jointly and severally firmly by these presents Sealed with our seals and dated this seventh day of July, in the year of our Lord, one thousand eight hundred and fifty six. The condition of the above obligation is such, that if the above bounden Robert Bell appointed Collector of Dorchester Coun-ty, shall well and faithfully execute his Office, and the several duties required of him, by Law, and shall well and truly account for, and pay to the County Commissioners for Dorchester County, or their order, the several sums of money which he shall receive or be answerable for by Law, at such time as the law shall direct, then the above obli-gation to be void, or else to be and remain in full force and virtue in law—
