Johnson, of Dorchester county, and State aforesaid, the receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained, sold and delivered, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and deliver unto the said Edward C. Johnson my two negro girls, Caroline aged four years and Mary Lane aged two years, Slaves for life, which said Slaves Caroline and Mary Lane, I will warrant and forever defend unto the said Edward C. Johnson, his executors, administrators, and assigns, against myself, my executors and administrators, and against every other person or persons whomsoever. In Witness whereof, I have hereunto set my name, and affixed my seal, this the 25<sup>th</sup>. day of June 1836
