

Cartram of Dorchester County, in consideration of Three Hundred Dollars paid me by Rose Ann Bannette of Dorchester County, do hereby bargain and sell to the said Rose Ann Bannette, the following property, one negro Girl Harriet, slave for life. Witness my hand and seal, this 29<sup>th</sup> day of September, in the year 1856.

 State of Maryland, Dorchester County, to wit: I hereby certify, that on this 29<sup>th</sup> day of September, personally appeared before the subscriber, as Justice of the Peace for Dorchester County, aforesaid, David M. Cartram, and acknowledged the foregoing Bill of Sale to be his act, and at the same time appeared Rose Ann Bannette, granted in the above Bill of Sale, and made oath that the consideration therein stated is just and true, as therein set forth.

 As it remembreth and it is hereby Certified, that the following Mortgage Bill of Sale was received and recorded on the 8<sup>th</sup> day of October 1856, to wit:  
 This Indenture, made this twentieth day of February, in the year of our Lord, Eighteen Hundred and Fifty six, between William Batchelor of Dorchester and State of Maryland of the one part, and James Murphy of Dorchester County and State aforesaid of the other part. Whereas, the said William Batchelor owes and stands justly indebted to the said James Murphy, in the sum of Sixty six Dollars Current money, and to secure the payment thereof is willing to execute these presents. Now this Indenture, Witnesseth, that the said William Batchelor, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Dollars Current money to him in hand paid by the said James Murphy, at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof the said William Batchelor doth hereby acknowledge, and thereof and therefrom doth acquit, acquitance and forever discharge, the said James Murphy, his heirs, executors and administrators, and every of them by these presents, hath granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents doth grant, bargain and sell, unto James Murphy, his Executors, administrators and assigns, all and singular the personal property hereinafter particularly mentioned and expressed (that is to say) one sowed mare, Betsey Cowkin, one Horse Cart, one light Baidle Case, and one steer yearling. Do Have and Do Hold all and singular the said personal property herein before granted, bargained and sold, or mentioned or intended so to be, unto the said James Murphy, his executors, administrators and assigns, forever; Provided Always, and these presents are upon this condition, that if the said William Batchelor, his executors or administrators, shall and do well and truly pay, or cause to be paid, unto the said James Murphy, his Executors, administrators or assigns, the full sum of sixty six Dollars Current money, with legal interest for the same, on or before the twentieth day of February, in the year of our Lord eighteen Hundred and Fifty seven, then and in such case these presents, and every matter and thing herein contained, shall cease, determine and be utterly void, to all intents and purposes, anything herein contained to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding; and the said William Batchelor, for himself, his heirs, Executors or administrators, or some or one of them, shall and well well and truly pay, or cause to be paid unto the said James Murphy, his executors, administrators and assigns the said sum of Sixty six Dollars, together with the interest for the same, at such time as in the within recited premises and condition herein mentioned and appointed for the payment thereof. And the said William Batchelor for himself, his executors and administrators, all and singular the said personal property by these presents granted, bargained and sold, and every part thereof, unto the said James Murphy, his executors, administrators and assigns, against him the said William Batchelor, his executors, administrators, and against all and every
