Know all men, by these presents, that I, Isaac Bailey of Dorchester County, in the State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and twenty five Dollars, Current money to me in hand paid by Charles Shenton of the County and State aforesaid, at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof I the said Isaac Bailey, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold and by these presents, do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Charles Shenton, his Executors, administrators and assigns: All the Goods, Household stuff, implements and Furniture particularly mentioned expressed and contained in the Schedule hereunto annexed, that is to say: two two horses, one yoke of Oxen, one Cow and calf, one heifer, five heads of hay, one Cart, one old Carriage, two ploughs, five stacks of Padder and four Barrels of Corn, all and which the said Goods and Chattels are now remaining, standing and being in a certain messuage or tenement situate in Black Water, or Commonly called Gum Swamp, and now in the occupation of the said Isaac Bailey. To Have and To Hold all and singular the said Goods, Household stuff and Furniture, and other the Premises above bargained and sold, or mentioned and intended so to be to the said Charles Shenton, his Executors, administrators and assigns forever, and I the said Isaac Bailey for myself, my heirs, Executors, administrators, all and singular the said Goods, Household stuff and furniture and other the Premises, unto the said Charles Shenton, his Executors, administrators and assigns, against me the said Isaac Bailey, my Executors and administrators, and against all and every other person or persons whatsoever, shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents, of all and singular which said Goods, Household stuff and Furniture, and other the Premises. I the said Isaac Bailey, have put the said Charles Shenton, in full possession by delivering to him the said Charles Shenton, one Horse at the sealing and delivering of these presents, in the name of the whole premises hereby bargained and sold or mentioned, and intended to be so unto him the said Charles Shenton aforesaid.
