of Maryland, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Maryland, in the full and just sum
of Two Hundred Dollars, Current money of Maryland, to be paid to the said State or its certain
Attorney, to the which payment well and truly to be made and done, we bind ourselves, our
heirs, Executors and administrators, in the whole and for the whole, jointly and severally firmly
by these presents, Sealed with our seals and dated this first day of January, Eighteen hun-
dred and fifty seven. Whereas, the County Commissioners for Dorchester County, by virtue
of a supplement entitled, "An additional supplement to the act to regulate Ferries, have con-
tracted with the said Robert M. Crighton, keep the Ferry over a place called the Nar-
rows on Deepers Island, and agree to allow the said Robert M. Crighton, the sum of One
Hundred and fifty Dollars Current money for the same. Now the condition of
the above obligation is such, if the above bounden Robert M. Crighton, shall well, faith-
fully and diligently keep the said Ferry over the place called the Narrows on Deepers
Island, from the dawn of day light in the morning until the expiration of day light
in the evening, each day, from the first day of January 1857, until the first day of Jan-
uary 1858, and shall keep constantly and in good order as sea as that will safely carry
three passengers and three horses at one trip with one able bodied and skilful hand
to attend the said Ferry, and shall not charge or receive any greater price for services
than what is allowed by law.
