





Deed of Manumission was received and recorded on the 22<sup>d</sup> day of June 1857  
from & by  Levi D. Travers  
Levi D. Travers of Dorchester County and State of Maryland  
do hereby manumit, set free my negro Slave Henry Camish, aged about  
25 years of age, about 6 feet high of dark chestnut color, bald headed & a rather pleas-  
ant countenance, his freedom to commence from the date of these presents. Witness my  
hand and seal this the 22<sup>nd</sup> day of June A. D. 1857.

Govaine Redditt  Be it remembered and it is hereby Certified, that the following Mortgage  
Bill of Sale was received and recorded on the 26<sup>th</sup> day of June 1857 to wit  
from & by  Oliver G. Foote  
Oliver G. Foote of Dorchester County State of Maryland, being now  
indebted to Govaine Redditt of said County & State, in the sum of  
Six Hundred Dollars, with interest from the twenty seventh day of April 1857, in  
consideration thereof, do hereby bargain and sell to the said Govaine Redditt the fol-  
lowing property viz my portable steam engine, Chronometer Watch, and all my House-  
hold furniture. Provided, that if the said O. G. Foote, shall pay to the said Govaine  
Redditt, the sum of Six Hundred Dollars with interest thereon, on or before the twenty seventh  
day of September 1857, then these presents shall be void; Provided further, that in  
default of payment the said Govaine Redditt, may sell the above mortgaged property  
in the following manner viz by giving ten days notice at the residence of the said O. G.  
Foote, and by advertising the said articles of property one time, in one of the Cambridge  
newspapers, giving notice therein of the day of sale, the amount of indebtedness which the  
above mortgaged property is intended to cover, and a general description of the property.
