done, we bind ourselves and each of our heirs, executors and administrators jointly and severally, firmly

by these presents, sealed with our seals and dated this the 24th day of May, Eighteen hundred

and fifty seven. — Whereas by an act of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January

Session Eighteen hundred and fifty six, Chapter One Hundred and twenty five, the above named

Thomas J. Dail, James A. Waddell and John G. Willis were appointed Commissioners to make sale

of the States interest in all the lands reserved and set apart for the use of the remnant of the Tribe

of Choptank Indians, or their descendants, by the Commissioners, Henry Waggoner, James Steele

Moses LeCompte and William Marbury, appointed by and under the provisions of the act of

Assembly passed at November Session, Seventeen hundred and ninety eight, Chapter eighty two. —

The Condition of the above obligation is such that if the above named Thomas J. Dail,

James A. Waddell and John G. Willis, shall well and faithfully perform the trust reposed

in them by the said recited act of Assembly passed at January Session 1857 Chapter 125,

or that may be reposed in them by any subsequent act, then the above obligation to be void,

otherwise to be and remain in full force and virtue in law. —
