Do Have and Do Hold the same described property, above bargained and sold to the same Francis Harvey, his Executors, administrators and assigns forever, to his and there only proper use and benefit, and I the said Margaret Dwyer, for myself, my Executors and administrators, shall and well warrant and forever defend by these presents to the said Francis Harvey, his executors, administrators and assigns, the said described property, against me, my executors and administrators, and against all and every other person or persons who hereafter, claiming the same or any part thereof.
