Dawson, all my right, title and interest, in and to the negroes hereinafter named which formerly belonged to James Muir, late of Dorchester County, deceased, viz: negro man called Daniel, negro man called Rachel, negro woman called Mary, negro girl called Marriet, and negro girl called Rhoda, all of which said negroes are slaves for life.
