one hog. Provided that if the said Wrightson Willey shall pay to  
the said Thomas Bradly the said sum of forty two dollars and fifty  
three cents with the interest thereon on or before the 19<sup>th</sup> day of Dec-  
ember 1858. then these presents shall be void otherwise to re-  
main in full force and virtue.
