

George Wing Know all men by these presents, that I, George Wing, Colored man, of
Dorchester County and State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum
of One Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Henry C. Elliott, of the County and State aforesaid, at or before the sealing and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof I the said George Wing, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents, do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Henry C. Elliott, his Executors, Administrators and assigns, Two
Horses, two yoke of Oxen and three other Cattle, two Carts, one sow and pigs and three head
of Sheep, and mow in my possession. To Have and To Hold the said described property to the
said Henry C. Elliott, his executors, administrators and assigns forever. Provided nevertheless that
in case I the said George Wing, shall pay and satisfy to the said Henry C. Elliott, or to his
executors, administrators or assigns, the sum of One Hundred dollars with interest for the same
an or before the first day of January next ensuing, then this Bill of Sale and every matter and
thing therein expressed shall be void, and of no effect, its being the true intent and meaning
thereof, that the said described property is mortgaged by me the said George Wing to secure
to the said Henry C. Elliott, the payment of the money aforesaid. In Witness Whereof, I the
