



Elliott Be it remembered and it is hereby Certified, that the following Bill of Sale, from <sup>27</sup> George Wing was received and recorded on the 16th day of January 1858, to wit: — Know all men by these presents, that I, George Wing, Colored man, of Worcester County and State of Maryland, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred dollars to me in hand paid by Henry C. Elliott, of the County and State aforesaid, etc as before the enrolling and delivering of these presents, the receipt whereof I the said George Wing, do hereby acknowledge, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents, do grant, bargain and sell unto the said Henry C. Elliott, his Executors, administrators and assigns, Two Horses, two yoke of Cows and three other Cattle, two Carts, one sow and pigs and three head of Sheep, and now in my possession. To Have and To Hold the said described property to the said Henry C. Elliott, his executors, administrators and assigns forever. Provided nevertheless that in case I the said George Wing, shall pay and satisfy to the said Henry C. Elliott, or to his executors, administrators or assigns, the sum of One Hundred dollars with interest for the same on or before the first day of January next ensuing, then this Bill of Sale and every matter and thing therein expressed shall be void, and of none effect, it being the true intent and meaning thereof, that the said described property is mortgaged by me the said George Wing to secure to the said Henry C. Elliott, the payment of the money aforesaid. In Witness Whereof, I the said George Wing, have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal, this 13th day of January, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight (1858)
